The Big Trees (the giants of the forest) are a great attraction for visitors. There is good hunting and fishing; 25,000 Eastern trout have been put in the mountain streams during the past year.

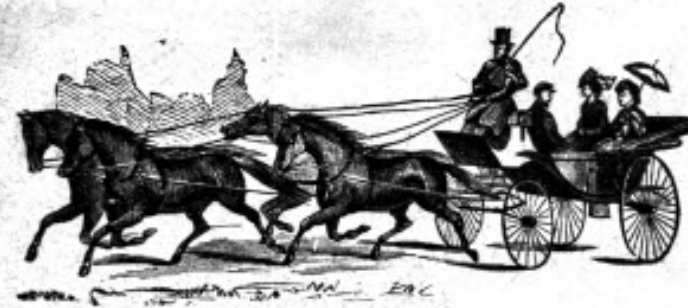
