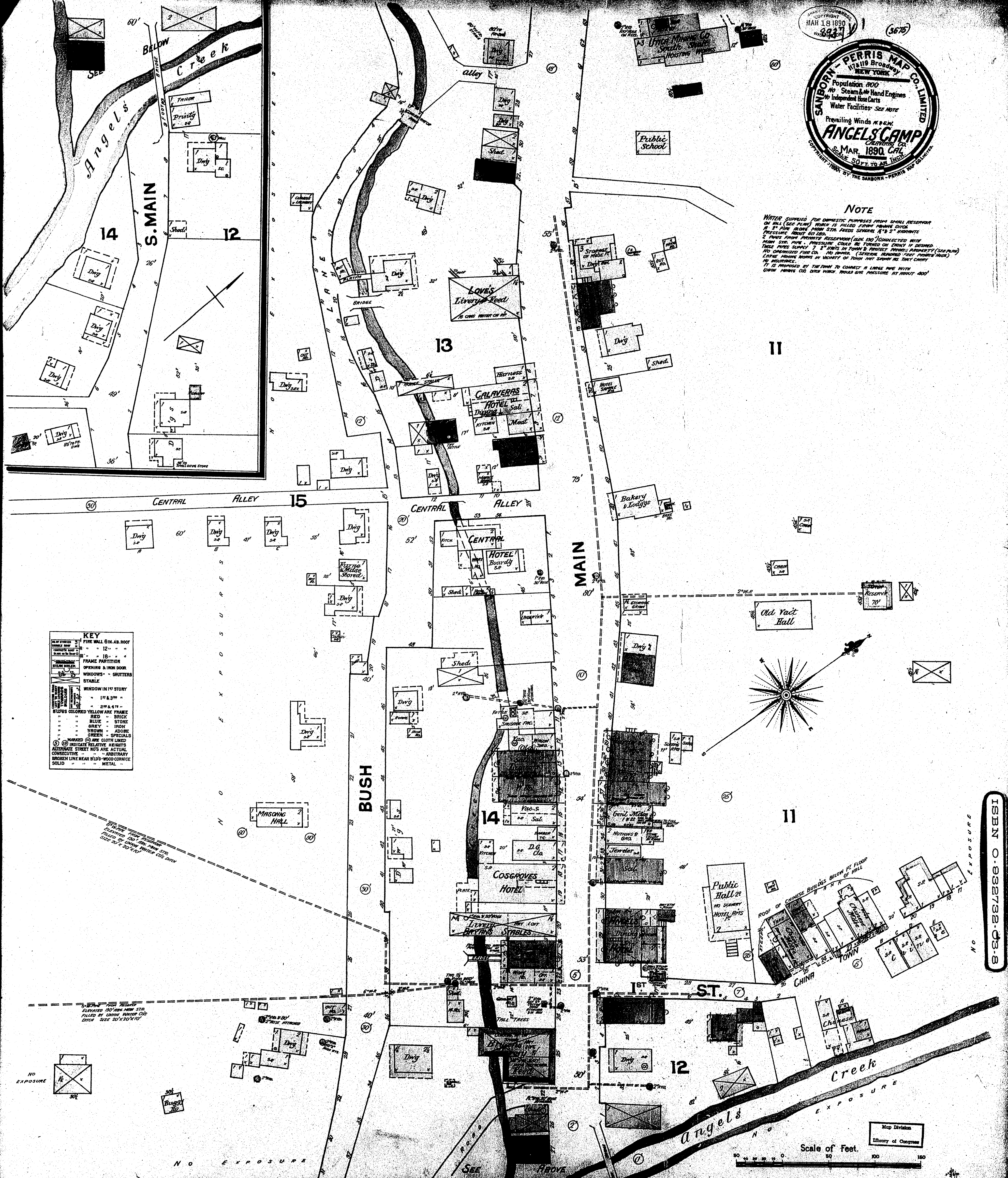
1. 2" FIRE ALONG MAIN ST. FEELS SEVERAL 1/2" 2" PRESSURES

2. PIPES FROM PRIVATE RESERVOIR (L.H. 120') CONNECTED WITH MAIN ST. PIPE. PRESSURE COULD BE TURNED ON DRYLY IF DESIRED. THESE PIPES SLIPWAY 7" 2" HITS IN TOWN & PROTECT PRIVATE PROPERTY (SEE PLAN)

NO ORGANIZED FIRE CO. IN TOWN. (SEE TOWN MAP FOR FIRE CO. NO. 10)

LARGE MINE WORKS IN VICINITY OF TOWN NOT SHOWN AS THEY CONTAIN NO RESERVOIR.
